What is a Physician Assistant (PA)?

- Physician Assistants (PAs) are health care professionals who work under the supervision of a physician.
- PA scope of practice is determined by their physician colleagues and the rules and regulations of the province in which they are practicing.
- PAs provide a broad range of health care services in primary and specialty care, including patient assessments, clinical investigations, diagnoses and treatment plans, therapeutic interventions, and counselling on preventive care.

Program Overview

The PA Program runs 24-months and is grounded in Problem-based, small-group and self-directed learning, promoting inter-professional education and training.

Year 1: Students are on campus participating in problem-based learning tutorials, medical simulations, large group sessions, anatomy sessions, professional competency curriculum, communications and clinical skills.

Year 2: Students will undertake 48 weeks of supervised core and elective clinical clerkship rotations across Ontario.

Admission Requirements

- Completion of a minimum of 2 years of undergraduate university
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA (OMSAS 4.0 scale)
- No specific course or background requirements
- No health care experience required
